

Key Points

Game time is **1 hour and 20 minutes**, *drop dead*.

The score reverts back to the previous inning if:

- The inning is not complete.
- The home team is losing and does not complete their at-bat.

If the away team is losing and finishes their top half of the inning before the hour and twenty, the score is final. The umpires will keep the official time clock.

Game Procedure

Teams will have **5-10 minutes** to warm up in between games. There is also a small area before the game for pitchers to warm up. 😝

Standings and Tiebreakers

Standings will be kept, and playoffs are on week 4. 🏆

- 2 points for a win.
- 1 point for a tie.

Tiebreakers (in order):

- 1. Head to head.
- 2. Runs allowed.
- 3. Runs scored. 🔢

Lineup and Runner Rules

- Continuous lineup: Can free sub or bat a certain number with subs.
- Courtesy runner for pitcher and catcher. It will be the last batted out in a continuous lineup, and a sub if not playing everyone.

Dome Specific Rules

A batted ball off the top of the dome:

- In the infield: Foul ball. X
- In the outfield: Umpire's discretion. Never an out. It is a foul ball, ground rule double, or a homer.

General Conduct

- USA softball rules will be followed.
- Any issues, the umpires have the final call. **\rightarrow**
- Arguing between the coaches, umpires, or fans will not be tolerated. This league is designed to give the girls a chance to see game action over the winter to stay sharp. \bigcirc
- Anyone who can't follow this will be asked to leave and will not be allowed to return. Any team
 not in compliance will be removed from the league.
